Stewart Park in Perth - With all the transphobia in the headlines, the concern about changing pronouns in schools, the mis-information being spread through the media, maybe it is time to put some of the confusion to rest. Being a brave, respectful place means that we create the space to have difficult conversations about uncomfortable topics. The Transgender Day of Remembrance is on Wednesday, November 20, 2024.

Transgender Day of Remembrance (TDOR) is an annual observance on November 20, that honors the memory of the transgender people whose lives were lost in acts of

anti-transgender violence. There will be a ceremony at the bandstand in Stewart Park in Perth. More info will be provided, when it becomes available. In Rainbow 101's time of remembering and respect for Trans People we will show "The Science of Being Transgender". There will be a short film (25 min) that explains being gender fluid and/or non-binary and about the transitioning process for trans individuals.
